NOTE: Most upper-level business courses have restricted enrollment. In addition to any other prerequisites listed, courses identified with an [R] in the Course column are restricted to students who have completed ACCT 2101, ACCT 2102, ECON 2105, and ECON 2106 with a grade of C or higher in each course. A grade of C or higher is required in the prerequisites for upper-level Business courses, in all major specific courses, and in BUSA 4995. Therefore, a grade of C or higher is required in the courses with a $\geq C$ in the C req. column. Courses labeled with an O or W are oral or writing intensive, respectively.

Major Specific - 21 hours (all with a grade of C or higher)

NOTE: The major courses in the Accounting major take a minimum of four semesters to complete. The sequence starts in the Fall in Dahlonega and in the Spring in the evening in Gainesville. The 4000 level courses are taught every other year in Gainesville.
