RATIONALE FOR JUDGMENT OF COMPLIANCE

North Georgia College & State University awards academic credit for course work taken on a non-credit basis only based on a student's military experience. This practice is based on BOR policy [1]. Students who have served on active duty or have attended military training may provide a copy of appropriate documentation (DD-214, AARTS transcript, SMAART transcript, etc.) that categorizes and defines the duties performed or skills learned by the student while he/she was serving. NGCSU uses the ACE Guide for Military Credits [2] as the course recommendation for credit for military experience. Credit for college level work is generally granted and placed on the student's transcript.
